

Sway Community Speed Watch report dated 11/03/2022

This month we conducted 8 speedwatch sessions, reporting 77 speeding vehicles to the police. Highest speed detected was 57 mph, though unfortunately we were unable to record full details of that vehicle, hence highest speed reported was 49 mph.

Again, a higher volume of traffic was observed this month especially on the B3055 which is being used as a diversion route while the bridge at Holmsley is being replaced.

What Vera Sees

Sway Parish Council's Vehicle Activated Speed Limit Reminder counts vehicles exceeding the 35mph reporting threshold. From this data we can extrapolate the total number of vehicles speeding through Sway each week. The chart below shows this, along with the 8 week rolling average trend line. The most recent temporary dip in the numbers speeding coincided with the half term week.
