Sway Community Speed Watch report dated 9/4/2022

This month we conducted 7 speedwatch sessions, reporting 62 speeding vehicles to the police. Highest speed detected was 50 mph – this was the same vehicle recorded last month doing 57 mph. That and one other were recorded speeding twice this month suggesting that more targeted enforcement may be required in addition to our Community SpeedWatch sessions.
